#### **COSTUME SIZING**

Costumes will be posted in your portal after 11/15. At that time we ask that you measure your dancer's chest, waist, hips, and girth and review those measurements with EACH costume company's size chart and select the appropriate size(s). We ask that you submit your dancer's sizes by 11/21 at the latest. If your dancer's measurements fall in between sizes, it is always better to size up. Taking in a costume is much better than having a costume that is too small. Measuring your dancer is very important. Costumes are custom made to order and in most cases can not be exchanged. Please remember that your dancer is growing and this costume needs to fit them in May! If you are unsure, please don't hesitate to ask for help. We also have some costume sizing kits available in the lobby to help you select costume sizes that will work for your dancer. And you can always ask for help from the front desk staff.

#### **IMPORTANT REMINDERS:**

- Students should refrain from bringing cell phones and smart watches into class, as they are disruptive to focus and learning. Cell phones must be stored and SILENCED.
- DO NOT reach out to teachers on their personal time by way of social media or their personal contact. All communication with teachers should be done through the Hershey School of Dance and Arts email address: hersheyschoolofdance@verizon.net. We are happy to connect teachers and students/parents to facilitate communication as needed.
- **Refrain from coming to dance classes if you are sick.** Please rest and return to dance when you are feeling better. Help keep our dance community healthy!
- Please arrive on time, ready to dance in proper dance attire and shoes, with hair pulled back securely away from face.
- Please encourage dancers to use the bathroom and wash hands before entering class.
- **Dress Code:** The discipline of dance requires students to **follow the dress code** for optimal learning. We have made several updates to our dress code, please find all the details in <u>The Student & Parent Handbook.</u>



#### **PARKING LOT SAFETY**

Dancers: Please wear street clothes or cover-ups to and from the building. Please wait inside the building to be picked up. With the change in outside temperatures it's important to have warm clothes to enter and leave the building in. Even if you're warm after class, you need to be dressed for the colder elements to prevent injuries. NO dance shoes in the parking lot or worn outside the building. The dirt and oils from the ground outside is harmful to our dance floors.
