Celebration 3 & 4: Spacing Rehearsal

To help dancers become familiar with this new performance venue, we are running our spacing **rehearsals differently than in past years**. We are running in blocks by act, in show order, and dancers will wait in their assigned dressing rooms. Please also take special note of the new DROP OFF/DISMISSAL process, page 6.

- **REHEARSALS:** All rehearsals for the week of May 18 will be held at the Whitaker Center. *NO* rehearsals or classes will be held at HSDA.
- **DROP OFF:** Dancers will enter through the backstage door located near 25 N Court St, Harrisburg. Parent drop off and car drop off will take place at this location. If you choose to park, please walk your dancer to the stage door listed above. Staff will greet dancers and guide them to their designated dressing room.
- **ARRIVAL:** Please be prompt so that rehearsals can begin and end on time. We will run spacing rehearsal in show order, by act, and dancers will wait for their turn in their assigned dressing room. Please see page 6 for detailed pick up/drop off instructions.
- **DRESS CODE:** Please arrive in dress code with proper dance wear, hair, and shoes for all dances. Costumes are not worn for spacing rehearsal.
- **SUPPLIES:** Please send water, nut-free snacks, and some simple entertainment so the dancers can enjoy the time in dressing rooms with their friends.
- **NO VISITORS:** Parents, non-students, or non-volunteers are not permitted past the stage door; viewing rehearsals is not permitted.
- **DISMISSAL:** Dancers will be dismissed at the backstage door immediately following rehearsal for their act. Please see the drop-off/pick up page for detailed instructions, and cut out your car tag for display. No student will be dismissed to a parent without the car tag. Please notify the office if additional car tags are needed for your family. Consider carpooling with other families to minimize traffic at pick up and drop off; remember to transfer your car tag!
- **CONSECUTIVE REHEARSALS:** Any student who is staying for consecutive rehearsals may stay in the building, but should check in again at the arrival door for their second rehearsal.
- **PLEASE NOTE:** All dancers stay for the entire spacing rehearsal for their act.

Spacing Callbacks

Monday & Tuesday, 7:15-9:00pm

We have built in extra rehearsal time Monday & Tuesday evenings from 7:15-9:00pm. This time will be used as needed. Following Sunday's spacing rehearsal, should your class need extra rehearsal, you will be notified via email.

Celebration 3 & 4: Dress Rehearsal

Wednesday, May 21, 4:45-9:00pm Arrival time: 4:30pm

Dress rehearsals run just like the show, with full hair and makeup, and in show order, but without an audience. **Please arrive promptly at arrival time** so that our rehearsals can start and finish on time, and our dancers can feel confident about the process.

- **ARRIVAL TIME 4:30 PM:** Please bring your dancers to the backstage door of the Whitaker Center near 25 N Court St, Harrisburg dressed in their (first) costume, hair and makeup done. *All costume pieces, accessories, shoes, etc. should be labeled with the student's name or initials.*
- **BRING:** Plan to bring a dance bag or backpack containing all needed dance shoes, all costume pieces, additional tights, hair supplies, dry (not messy) snacks and water, and something clean to do for fun during down-time.
- NOTE: To make this practice as much like the actual show as possible, we will run in show
 order and students will wait in assigned dressing rooms. Dancers will stay for the entire
 rehearsal.
- QUICK CHANGES: Any dancer who has a "quick change" between two of their dances will
 receive detailed instructions and materials in the weeks leading up to the show to make that
 process smooth and successful. There will be helpers for quick changes. If you have not been
 designated a "quick change," you will have time to return to your regular dressing room
 between dances.
- **BEFORE YOU LEAVE:** Dancers should check that every costume, shoe, and accessory is still in their possession. Any quick change materials should be retrieved from the quick change area.
- **DISMISSAL: 9:00 PM** at the backstage door, near 25 N Court St, Harrisburg. Please follow our drop-off/pick up procedures on page 6, and display your car tag.
- **AT HOME:** Check that your dancer has all their costume pieces, tights, and shoes. Organize and prepare them for the recital.

Celebration 3: Recital

Show begins at 6:30pm on Saturday, May 24. All dancers, regardless of what act(s) they perform in, are called at 5:45pm.

DROP OFF: Please follow the same drop-off procedure that was used for spacing and dress rehearsals. Families can then secure parking and enter the Whitaker Center through the main lobby entrance at 222 Market St, Harrisburg.

ARRIVAL 5:45pm: Please be sure to bring dancers ready in their (first) costume, with hair and makeup done. Make sure they have all of the shoes and additional costume pieces they will need for their performances.

POST-RECITAL DISMISSAL: Following the recital, students will be brought by class to the **Whitaker Center lobby** for pick up. Any parents not in attendance at the recital should come inside the lobby for pick up.

Celebration 4: Recital

Sunday, May 25, 2:00pm ARRIVAL TIME: 1:15pm

Show begins at 2:00pm on Sunday, May 25. All dancers, regardless of what act(s) they perform in, are called at 1:15pm. Read below for more detailed instructions.

DROP OFF: Please follow the same drop-off procedure that was used for spacing and dress rehearsals. Families can then secure parking and enter the Whitaker Center through the main lobby entrance at 222 Market St, Harrisburg.

ARRIVAL 1:15pm: Please be sure to bring dancers ready in their (first) costume, with hair and makeup done. Make sure they have all of the shoes and additional costume pieces they will need for their performances.

POST-RECITAL DISMISSAL: Following the recital, students will be brought by class to the **Whitaker Center lobby** for pick up. Any parents not in attendance at the recital should come inside the lobby for pick up.

MEMORIES:

- Families will be able to purchase HSDA merch and show gifts in the Whitaker Center lobby before the show and at intermission.
- Feel free to capture these special memories with photos, but NO flash photography, and NO videos may be taken during performances. Our show is being professionally recorded, DVDs and Digital Downloads will be available for preorder from Mack Video Productions. See order info included.

Drop-off/Pick Up Procedures Rehearsals and Recitals

STAGE DOOR LOCATION: Drop offs will take place at the stage door. While the stage door does not have its own address, it is located on the West side of the building, between Hilton and Whitaker with the door located on Court Street. The closest address is **25 N Court Street**. As you make your way to that address, you will see the large Whitaker loading dock & stage door just before Strawberry Street.

- All drop offs will take place at the backstage door near 25 N Court St, Harrisburg.
- Please arrive at the designated arrival time for all rehearsals and the show.
- We ask parents to stay in their vehicles, and pull forward to the designated drop-off area. Students must exit their vehicle on the curb side, where helpers will be waiting to escort them to their class.
- Parents who prefer local street parking or garage parking should walk their child to the drop-off location.
- Due to the volume of student drop-off and pick-ups, there may be a wait. Please plan accordingly and for everyone's safety, do not pass other waiting vehicles.
- For spacing and dress rehearsals, all pick ups will take place at the backstage door near 25 N Court St, Harrisburg. Students will stay together with their classes inside the Whitaker Center while waiting for pick up. Please stay in your vehicle, display your pick-up/dismissal car tag by hanging it from your rear view mirror, and pull forward to the pick-up location. Staff members/helpers will bring your child to your vehicle. Cut out the tag on the last page of your recital packet and as clearly as possible add your dancer's last and first names. Please notify the office if additional tags are needed.
- Parents who prefer local street parking or garage parking should walk to the pick-up location.
- Mark your car tag clearly with your family's name in bold lettering.
- If you choose to carpool, be sure your car tag transfers with your dancer's ride.
- Any student who is staying for consecutive rehearsals will stay in the building, and should report to the check in table for each subsequent rehearsal; dancers will not need to exit the building.
- Please pack a meal, adequate snacks, and hydration for long rehearsals. Leaving to get food is not permitted.
- Following the recital, students will be brought by class to the Whitaker Center lobby for pick up. Any parents not in attendance at the recital should come inside the lobby for pick up.

ACTION ITEMS: Cut out car tag, boldly write your family name, and display for all pick up and drop offs.





Makeup Tips:

- •Neutral eye: browns/pinks, mascara, eyelashes optional, blush, red lips, no nail polish*, show earrings optional, no other jewelry. For dancers that have fake nails, please be natural; French or clear.
- Sleek hair, using gel or hairspray, hair nets for buns.
- •Be sure to pack extra hair supplies in your dancer's bag, including hair brush, hair spray, hair ties, bobby pins, & hair pins that match your dancer's hair; no bright colors.
- •Be sure to label costumes, tights, shoes, etc. with the dancer's name. Remove visible tags; usually on white or light colored costumes.

Wellness: Make sure your dancer has a healthy meal and is hydrated before coming to rehearsals.

Will any rehearsals or classes take place at the studio show week?

NO! All rehearsals beginning May 18 will be at the Whitaker Center. Enter through the stage door. Viewing of rehearsals is not permitted.

Do dancers need to attend both spacing rehearsals & dress rehearsal?

YES! Notify our office immediately of any conflicts to hersheyschoolofdance@verizon.net

Will my matinee dancer have help?

YES! Each dressing room will have assistants to help dancers with costume changes, hair, and bathroom visits. Hall monitors will be located backstage.

Are tickets limited per family?

NO. However the Whitaker Center is a smaller venue, advance purchase is recommended.

Can we film dances during the performance?

NO! You may purchase a DVD or digital download from Jeff Mack Productions.

Will you have recital shirts for sale?

Recital shirts are available for PRE ORDER through April 7. To guarantee size and color preference orders MUST be placed in advance.


