- 1. We are accepting photo and/or short video submissions of HSDA dancers posed or dancing next to a street sign with your name on it. We will also accept submissions of you posed or dancing in the streets around town or in other towns and cities you visit while traveling. Selected submissions will be compiled into a montage video to play during the recital.

In addition, we know we have many talented artists in our dance family, so we would like to once again announce a call for submissions of original artwork related to the theme of Dancing in the Streets to be incorporated in our 2024 recital. All forms of art are welcome: photography, painting, poetry, sculpture, textile arts, video, drawing, digital art, illustrations, writing, et al. The deadline for photo/video submissions and original art submissions is March 15, 2024.
