INTERNATIONAL DAY OF DANCE FUNDRAISER FOR WORLD CENTRAL KITCHEN


For this year's International Dance Day we are throwing a **DANCE PARTY!**

For the dancer with some experience that wants to further their study of dance. 2 hours of instruction/day in various styles for 5 consecutive days. Daytime Monday-Friday. Classes in various styles including- ballet, tap, jazz, hip hop, and more. Open to dancers ages 9-11 with 3 years experience.

DRESS CODE

It is important that students of all ages and abilities follow the dress code for their dance classes. Arriving for class in the proper dress code sets the intention for learning. You would not send your child to soccer practice without their shin guards or to their violin lesson without their violin. Parents, please help them have the most positive outcome from their class time by having them in dress code, which includes their hair pulled away from the face. Older dancers, please take ownership of this aspect of your study and set a good example for our younger students. HELP KEEP THE LOBBY TIDY

Our lobby area is a shared space and we love that. It serves as a place to prep for class, eat dinner, and do homework. Please treat it with respect, as if it is your home. **We kindly ask dancers to clean up after yourself and parents to clean up after your young children. Please dispose of trash in provided receptacles. Clean up <u>all</u> crumbs and spills. If you need assistance, please ask.**

PARKING LOT SAFETY
